## **Bathurst Goldfields**

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This Thursday, 16 May, is our big day trip to the Bathurst Goldfields.

We will be departing **Luddenham Public School** at **7:15am sharp**; we will not be able to wait for students who are late!

Students must be dressed in appropriate casual clothes; we will be working outdoors all day. A jacket for a cool weather change and closed in shoes will be necessary. The program will continue regardless of the weather, so a plastic poncho for rain should also be packed.

Students must bring their recess, lunch and drinks in a small back pack. The students will be required to carry their own back packs. Your child will also need afternoon tea for our stop over at Mt York (it is advisable to have this packed separately to the rest of their food). Please remember it is a long day so additional snacks/fruit should be packed.

There is a souvenir shop at the goldfields. Your child may purchase a gold coin for \$4, leaf gold in a tube for \$10, assortments of minerals/crystals and many other things. I recommend no more than \$20 per child to be taken on the excursion. Your child will be responsible for the safety of their own spending money on the day.
